
1-Yr Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)


Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- A diploma-specific foundation programme conducted over two academic semesters
- PFP students are given provisional places in diploma programmes, subject to them passing all modules in the oneyear PFP.
- Offered by the 5 Polytechnics



Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- A two-year Higher Nitec course at ITE.
- DPP students who successfully complete their Higher Nitec courses and attain the required minimum qualifying Higher Nitec Grade Point Average (GPA) scores are guaranteed a place in one of the polytechnic diploma courses that are mapped to their Higher Nitec course.

- 5. Science: Science (Chemistry, Biology) or Science (Chemistry, Physics)

Offering of Express Subjects (Subject-Based Banding)

Students will be eligible to offer Express subjects (SBB) in Sec 3N(A) if they meet the following criteria:


Subject	Qualifying Criteria	
Express English	Overall English ≥ 70% Recommendation by English HOD	
Express Mother Tongue	Overall Mother Tongue ≥ 70% Recommendation by Mother Tongue HOD	
Express Mathematics	Overall Mathematics ≥ 70% Recommendation by Math HOD	
Express Combined Science (Physics/Chemistry)	Overall Science ≥ 70% Recommendation by Science HOD	
Humanities Subject(s)	Overall Humanities Subject(s) ≥ 70% Recommendation by Humanities HOD	

Students already offering SBB subjects in Lower Sec need only to pass the subject to continue in Sec 3.


